Recommended event formats:

Scramble Each player hits a tee shot. The team selects the best tee shot and all players hit from that ball's location. This process is continued until the ball is holed. One score is recorded for the hole. This is a great format if you have a lot of higher handicap players or if the handicap of most players is unknown.

Pairing recommendation:

- A player (low handicapper)
- B player (average)
- C player (high handicapper)
- D player (novice)

Best Ball Each player plays his or her own ball on each hole. The player's handicap is applied to give the player shots according to each hole specified handicap. This gives the player a "net" score for the hole. The best net score of the team is used as the team's best ball score for that hole. Teams can be 2 or 4 players. It is recommended that pairings be done similarly to the scramble format. *Players' handicaps are required prior to play and should be included with your pairings.*

Recommended Special Events:

Proximity Markers

- Longest Drive in the Fairway – Best Holes – 2, 15
- Closest to the Pin on the Par 3's – Best Holes – 6, 13
- Longest Putt Made – Best Holes – 4, 17



COURSE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Rules and Regulations

- Each player must have a set of golf clubs.
- All guests must take a golf cart.
- Flat soled, tennis, or golf shoes with *soft-spikes only*.
- *Appropriate golf attire is required.* Shirts must have sleeves and collars; although, sleeveless and appropriate tee shirts are acceptable attire for ladies. Denim jeans and jean shorts are not allowed nor are short shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts, bathing suits, or soiled or excessively worn clothing. Shorts must be at least 3 inches above the knee. Halter tops are not allowed.
- All players must check-in at the pro shop at least 15 minutes before the scheduled tee time.
- No more than four players per group. Pro Shop reserves the right to complete foursomes with other players.
- Wyoming law prohibits bringing your own alcohol onto our licensed premises. All Food and Beverage arrangements must be made through the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club by calling 307-733-7787.
- No outside food may be brought onto premises. All food must be purchased through Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club, unless other arrangements are made with Food and Beverage at 307-733-7787.
- No pets of any kind are allowed on the golf course or course grounds.
- All players, regardless of age, must pay the appropriate green fees.
- Players under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult, and display adequate golf knowledge to the Professional staff.
- Non golf related traffic is not permitted on the golf course.
- Rain Checks will be issued for inclement weather. These Rain Checks will be issued if the golfer has completed four or less holes of the nine holes paid.
- The practice facility will be made available to non-players for an additional fee.



Motorized Carts

- Motorized carts are mandatory.
- In order to drive a cart, all players must be sixteen years old, possess a valid drivers license, and sign a cart release.
- Only two riders per cart.
- All carts must stay on the cart paths when possible. Carts must stay at least fifty feet from greens. Please minimize cart traffic in the fairways.

Spectators

- Spectators may be allowed at the discretion of the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club.
- Spectators under the age of twelve are not allowed. Spectators are to remain spectators (not players), and adhere to the rules and regulations set forth by the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club including the dress code. Players are responsible for the safety of the spectators, as well as maintaining proper etiquette with regard to the other players and the golf course.
- Spectators **MUST** ride in the cart.

- Spectators **MUST** pay the per person cart fee.
- Spectators without a valid driver's license may not drive the cart.
- Spectators are not allowed to hunt for balls or wander away from the group for the benefit of safety and speed of play.

Golf Etiquette

- We realize that you may be unfamiliar with the course. A starter is on the 1st tee to answer any questions you may have
- Maximum time spent looking for a lost ball (per U.S.G.A. rules book) is 5 minutes.
- When your turn presents itself, be ready to hit. Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club golf shall take no longer than four hours and fifteen minutes. *Please play ready golf!*
- Allow faster groups to play through.
- Anyone stopping at the Halfway House may lose his or her position on the course.
- Replace divots. Please use the sand provided on the carts and tees.
- Repair your ball mark and at least one other.
- Rake bunkers after your shot.
- Play without delay.
- Please observe the rules of golf and our local rules and regulations.



Lightning

- **AVOID** open areas, wet areas and hilltops.
- **AVOID** solitary trees.
- **AVOID** all metallic objects, fences and power lines.
- **AVOID** golf carts, electrical and maintenance machinery.
- **SEEK** lower elevation areas.
- **SEEK** dense areas of trees, bushes.
- **SEEK** protected designated shelters.
- **SEEK** a crouching position with feet together.

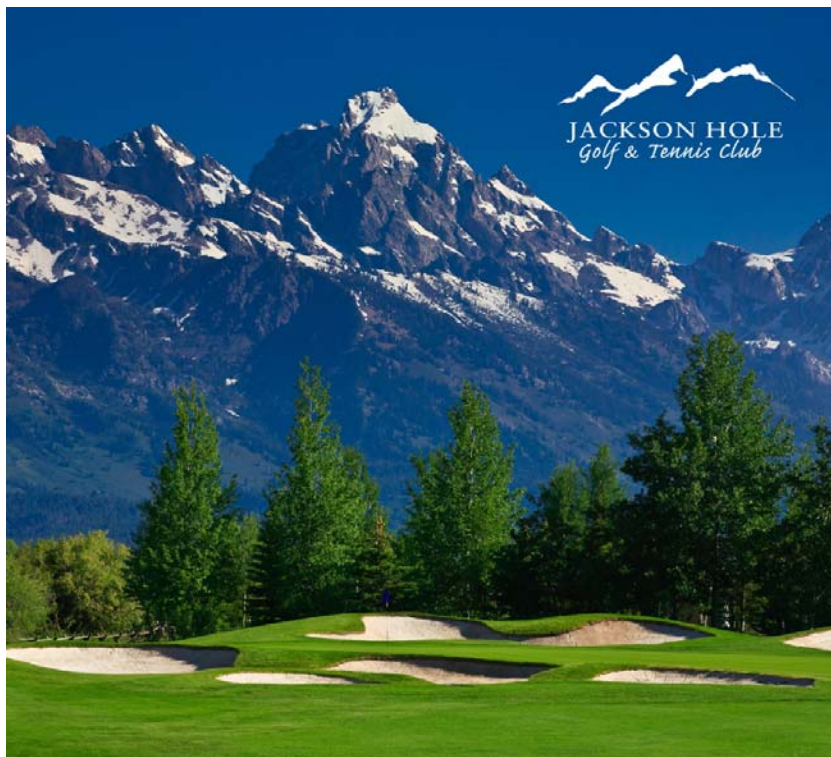

- As mutually agreed under the terms of this contract and upon execution, the Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club agrees to take out of inventory, and the group agrees to fully utilize, the tee times blocked with the number of players as outlined above.

- **Jackson Hole Golf & Tennis Club HAS A 30 DAY CANCELLATION POLICY FOR ALL GROUPS OF 16 PLAYERS OR MORE OR ALL FEES MAY BE CHARGED. IF A GROUP DROPS BELOW 16 PLAYERS, THE REGULAR RATE WILL BE CHARGED.** Any attrition or adjustments to the player number may be made between contract signing and 30 days prior to play without penalty. All unused CONTRACTED times not previously cancelled will be charged the full green fee.

EXHIBIT A TERMS AND CONDITIONS

RESERVATIONS: The Reservations phone number is _____ (Fax (307) 733-8473). Please advise your attendees to refer to the Group code indicated on the front side of this contract when making a reservation by phone or fax. No shows, late arrivals and early departures will be charged the deposit and rate indicated for the entire reserved stay. All reservations will require a deposit, balance due upon departure.

**Individual cancellations within 30 days of arrival are subject to forfeiture of full deposit amount. Individual cancellations outside of 30 days of arrival will result in return of the deposit fee less a \$30.00 processing fee. Emergency situations will be considered on an individual basis by the Reservations Manager. Documentation may be required.

No shows, and late arrivals will be charged to the Group Master Account at the contracted rate(s) for the entire reserved event.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: All food and beverage must be catered through JHGTC utilizing JHGTC's current menu packet and shall be subject to a separate Catering Agreement with JHGTC. JHGTC will charge the credit card on file for the Master Account for any food and beverage purchases not paid prior to departure.

FORCE MAJEURE: Except for any payment obligations, neither party shall be deemed to be in default or liable for any delays in the event and to the extent that performance thereof is delayed or prevented by extreme acts of God, civil disorder, labor dispute, fire, flood, or explosion.

INDEMNITY: Damage to JHGTC premises caused by the Group, its members, invitees and attendees or its appointed outside contractors will be the Group's responsibility. JHGTC shall not be responsible for any loss or damage no matter how caused, to any samples, displays, properties or personal effects brought into JHGTC. The Group shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless JHGTC and its owners, officers, directors, agents and employees from and against any and all demands, claims, damages to persons or property (including death), losses and liabilities, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or incurred due to the Group's acts, omissions, or negligence in connection with Group's activities pursuant to this contract, its provision of services or the use of JHGTC facilities.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: THE LIABILITY OF JHGTC SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE AMOUNT OF FEES PAID UNDER THIS AGREEMENT TO JHGTC. IN NO EVENT SHALL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER PARTY FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION LOSS OF PROFITS, REVENUES, WHETHER FORESEEABLE OR NOT, INCURRED OR SUFFERED BY THE OTHER PARTY OR ANY THIRD PARTY, WHETHER IN AN ACTION IN CONTRACT OR TORT, EVEN IF THE OTHER PARTY OR ANY OTHER PERSON HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF DAMAGES.

MISCELLANEOUS: This contract shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Wyoming. Jurisdiction and venue shall conclusively be deemed proper in the state or federal courts of the State of Wyoming. This contract shall be binding on and for the benefit of the parties and their successors and assigns. This contract contains the entire agreement of the parties with reference to the subject matter and provisions hereof, and may be altered, amended or modified only in writing by the parties. One or more waivers of any term or condition of this contract by either party shall not be construed as a waiver of subsequent breach of the same term or condition. The consent or approval by either party to or of any act by the other party requiring such consent or approval shall not be deemed to waive or render unnecessary consent to or approval of any subsequent act. In the event of a dispute arising out of this Agreement, the prevailing party, in any such dispute, shall be entitled to an award of its reasonable attorney's fees and costs.
