

GENERAL POOL RULES

- 1. Lifeguards are not in use at the Club. Use of the pool at any time is at the swimmer's own risk. Any injuries or accidents should be reported to the attendant immediately.
- 2. Members must register their guests with the attendant and are responsible for the payment of any appropriate charges as the Club may determine from time to time. All members shall present their membership cards at registration upon request.
- 3. Children 12 years and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
- 4. Children who cannot swim must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times while in any of the pool areas.
- 5. Children age three years and under must wear a waterproof swim diaper under their bathing suit at all times while in the pool. No bare bottom children will be permitted at any time.
- 6. Swimming is permitted only during designated hours. The pool is officially closed when a "CLOSED" sign is posted.
- 7. Showers are required before entering the pool.
- 8. Persons having a skin disease, sore or inflamed eye, cold, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease may not enter the pool.
- 9. Bottles, glass objects, drinking glasses and sharp objects are not permitted in the pool area. Trash should be placed in the proper receptacles located throughout the pool area.
- 10. Food is allowed only in designated areas of the pool facilities.
- 11. All swimmers must wear bona fide swimming attire. Cut-offs, dungarees and bermuda shorts are not considered appropriate swimwear. Proper non-swim attire is required at all times in the clubhouse, other than in the locker rooms. Shoes and foot coverings and caftans or shirts must be worn outside the swimming pool area.
- 12. Golf shoes are not allowed inside the pool enclosure. Street shoes are not allowed inside the sixfoot apron surrounding the pool. Tennis shoes with non-marking soles are allowed as are sandals and casual footwear with non-marking soles.
- 13. Radios, televisions and the like are permitted only with personal headphones and at a sound level which is not offensive to other members and guests. All electronic devices must be battery operated.

- 14. Animals, bicycles, skateboards and play balls of any type are not permitted in the pool areas.
- 15. Lifesaving and pool cleaning equipment should be used only for the purposes intended.
- 16. Running, ball playing and hazardous activities are not permitted in the pool areas. Pushing, dunking and dangerous games are prohibited.
- 17. Diving is not permitted unless otherwise indicated at the pool.
- 18. Snorkeling, fishing and spear fishing equipment, other than a mask and snorkel, are not to be used in the pool areas except as part of an organized course of instruction.
- 19. Throwing footballs, frisbees, tennis balls, or other objects, spitting or spouting water, and tag games are not allowed in the pool area. Management has the authority to expel from the pool areas anyone who does not follow these Pool Rules or whose conduct is otherwise unbecoming of a member.
- 20. Swimming parties may be arranged through the Club in advance of the occasion.
- 21. All persons using pool furniture are required to cover the furniture with a towel when using suntan oils and lotions, as the use of these oils and lotions could stain or damage the furniture.
- 22. All persons using the pool area are urged to cooperate in keeping the area clean by properly disposing of towels, cans, cigarettes, and all other trash in the proper receptacles.
- 23. Smoking is permitted only in designated sections of the pool area.
- 24. Flotation devices are permitted and small toys such as balls, water guns, rings, etc., may be permitted, depending on the number of persons in the pool and the manner in which the toys are used. Air mattresses may be permitted, depending on the size of the mattress and the number of persons in the pool. Management has the authority to discontinue use of these flotation devices, toys and mattresses upon the determination that they present a safety hazard or hinder the enjoyment of the pool by others. Tire inner tubes are not permitted at any time.
- 25. Persons who leave the pool area for over 30 minutes must relinquish lounges and chairs by removing all towels and personal belongings. Saving chairs for persons absent from the pool area is prohibited.
- 26. In the event the pool has been contaminated due to fecal or other matter, management will immediately close the pool and conduct chemical sanitation. The length of closure will be determined based on the severity of the contamination in the sole discretion of management.

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
